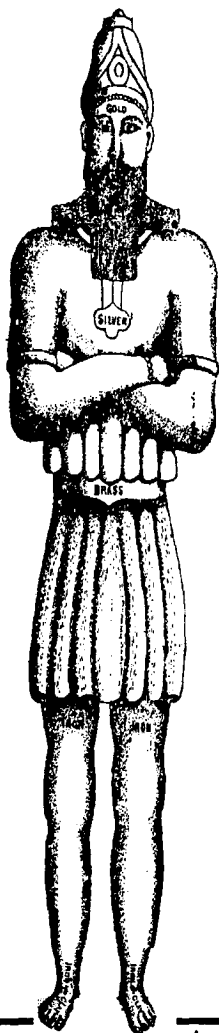

Two witnesses killed.
